Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training has been implemented in Delaware since 2014, but follow-up trainings for trained officers have not been widely implemented. Thanks to the federal Connect & Protect grant, NAMI Delaware is able to work on offering and improving the Advanced CIT session first developed with New Castle County Police Department.

### Pre-requisites: Law Enforcement Officers who have attended the full 40-hour CIT training

In this 16-hour class, sessions will expand on topics first introduced in the original 40-hour course for a deeper understanding. New populations not previously touched on in the original course due to time constraints will also be included. Potential topics are: domestic violence, youth, and intellectual/developmental disabilities. As presentations will assume that the foundation of CIT and de-escalation has already been laid, only officers that have been CIT trained previously are eligible for this training.
