Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training has been implemented in Delaware since 2014, but follow-up trainings for trained officers have not been widely implemented. Thanks to the federal Connect & Protect grant, NAMI Delaware is able to work on offering and improving the Advanced CIT sessions.

Pre-requisites: Individuals who are part of a Co-Responder Team who have attended the full 40-hour CIT training

The Co-Responder Model of a law enforcement officer and a clinician riding together for mental health related calls has become a very popular model in Delaware. As more departments in the state put together these types of teams, there's an increased need for bringing the officers and clinicians that are part of co-responder teams together to share knowledge. The sessions throughout the day will be tailored to topics for co-responders, such as REDCAP, case reviews, and finding potential funding sources.
